

**VILLAGE OF MEACHAM**  
**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A WATERWORKS CAPITAL INVESTMENT STRATEGY**  
**BYLAW # 01-24**

WHEREAS Council has established a Bylaw to Provide for a Waterworks Capital Investment Strategy.

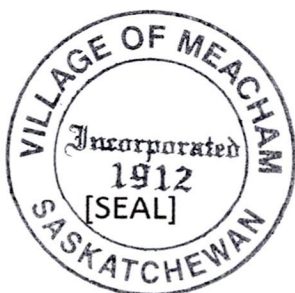
The Council of the Village of Meacham in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That the objective of the Waterworks Capital Investment Strategy is to address anticipated waterworks infrastructure maintenance, the immediate drinking water infrastructure problems and future infrastructure replacements in a timely fashion so as to ensure the municipal waterworks provides safe drinking water to residents.
2. Council will adopt a bylaw to set water rates that will cover present waterworks costs and allow any amounts collected above annual waterworks costs to be set aside in a waterworks reserve. These funds, and any interest earned on those funds, will be used to cover future infrastructure maintenance and replacement.

Read a third time and hereby adopted on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2024.
